With effect from 01.01.2020 the fees for the IFS Standards will increase from 250,-- € to 300,-- € and for the IFS Global Market Assessments from 25,-- € to 35,-- €. The fees for auditor examinations, auditor calibration training (CT) and train-the-trainer courses remain unchanged.

The new IFS Schedule of Fees No. 8 is attached to this letter.

You will surely notice that we only increase the costs that you usually pass on directly to your customers. The cost items that are initially to be borne directly by you and that you can only pass on indirectly to your customers via your costing are not affected by this.

At this point, we would like to emphasize that by adjusting the fees, we will be able to provide more services for IFS-certified companies. The IFS Trend Risk Monitor, which has now gone online, is available to all IFS-certified companies at no additional cost via the IFS Database access. The IFS Worldcloud, which is expected to be available online in autumn and will summarise visually intuitively the food warning notifications of the EU, US (FDA) and UK (FSA) on the basis of artificial intelligence, will also be offered without additional fees. In future, we will continue to develop normative documents and guidelines (e.g. Product Fraud), translate them into various languages and offer them as free downloads.

We will inform you at an early stage so that you can already take the increase in fees into account in your offers to your customers.

We will be happy to answer any questions you may have and look forward to further cooperation.
